Q: Will the dancer make it onto a team?

A: Most dancers make a team or are recommended for more recreational classes to build readiness. Auditions are to determine the best fit/placement.

Q: I see ballet is an audition day, do you compete in ballet?

A: We do not compete groups in ballet, but all dancers who do jazz/lyrical are required to take ballet for technique. If a dancer is auditioning for Jazz/Lyrical, they must also audition for their ballet technique placement. We do consider extra work in ballet.

Q: How much does dance team cost?

A: Cost varies greatly by the age of the dancer, how many styles they compete in, and if they do extra work. After auditions, you will receive a contract that outlines the costs by month so you can calculate the costs. You can also look at this years contract to start to see the cost info.

Q: What are the time commitments for team dancers?

A: Time commitments vary by the age of the dancer, how many styles they compete in, and if they do extra work. After auditions, you will be able to view the schedule (day/times) for your dancer.

Q: What is "extra work"?

A: Dancers are auditioning to be part of a group routine in particular style(s). This means they will be placed in a group that will learn a dance and compete that dance for the 2024-25 season at different recitals and competitions. In addition to these groups, some dancers may audition for extra work which is an extra dance that is in addition to the group/styles. Extra work can be a solo dance, a duo or trio, or a small group.

Q: What are the required dates/events for 2024-25?

A: We do not have all the dates yet, but when contracts are issued after auditions, the contract will include a calendar. The calendar will list which events are required for each group/style for the season.

Q: How will I get support understanding some of the information after I get the contract?

A: We will host a new to team meeting via zoom to go through the contract you are offered and answer any questions (ex: what is the difference between convention and competition?)
